14	(1) ran out of usable ballots during voting hours; and
15	(2) did not receive supplemental ballots under Section
16	51.008 for one or more hours after making a request for supplemental
17	ballots to the authority responsible for distributing election
18	supplies.
19	Sec. 249.002. PROCEDURES FOR NEW ELECTION. In establishing
20	the procedures for a new election ordered under this chapter, the
21	secretary of state shall have the same authority granted to a
22	district court under Section 231.007.
23	Sec. 249.003. EXPENSES OF NEW ELECTION. The expenses of a
24	new election ordered by the secretary of state under this chapter

- 1 are paid from the same fund and by the same authority that paid the
- 2 <u>expenses of the previous election.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 4 an election ordered on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
