 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to operating requirements for farm mutual insurance
 1-24 companies related to insurance in force on rural property.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 911.301, Insurance Code, is amended by
 1-27 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (e) and (f) to read
 1-28 as follows:

1-29 (a) In this section:

1-30 (1) "Census year" means a year in which the United
 1-31 States Census Bureau conducts a federal decennial census.

1-32 (2) "Rural [~~,"rural]~~ property" means property located
 1-33 outside an area of land subject to the taxing authority of a
 1-34 municipality with a population of more than 6,500, adjusted in
 1-35 accordance with Subsection (e) [2,500].

1-36 (e) On January 1 of the second year following a census year,
 1-37 the population limit described by Subsection (a)(2) increases or
 1-38 decreases by a percentage that is equal to the percentage increase
 1-39 or decrease in the population of this state from the previous
 1-40 decennial census.

1-41 (f) Not later than November 1 of the year following a census
 1-42 year, the commissioner shall:

1-43 (1) compute the new population limit in accordance
 1-44 with Subsection (e); and

1-45 (2) publish the limit on the department's Internet
 1-46 website.

1-47 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
