- SECTION 1. Section 701.002, Occupations Code, is amended by 4
- amending Subdivision (1-a) and adding Subdivisions (1-b) and (1-c) 5
- to read as follows: 6
- (1-a) "Certifying entity" means the Commission on 7
- Dietetic Registration or another entity that is accredited by the 8
- National Commission for Certifying Agencies or the American 9
- National Standards Institute to issue credentials for the 10
- professional practice of dietetics and is approved by the 11

- $\underline{\text{(1-b)}}$ "Commission" means the Texas Commission of 13

- SECTION 2. Sections 701.251(b) and (c), Occupations Code, 19
- are amended to read as follows: 20

- 22 under this chapter, a person may not:
- 23 (1) use the title or represent or imply that the person
- has the title "licensed dietitian" [or "provisional licensed 24

- 1 dietitian"] or use the letters "LD" [or "PLD"]; or
- 2 (2) use a facsimile of that title [those titles] to
- 3 indicate or imply that the person is a licensed dietitian [ox
- 4 provisional licensed dietitian].
- 5 (c) Unless the person is a dietitian registered by the
- 6 Commission on Dietetic Registration, a person may not:

- SECTION 3. Subchapter F, Chapter 701, Occupations Code, is

- Sec. 701.2525. LICENSE QUALIFICATIONS. An applicant for a
- 16 dietitian license must provide evidence satisfactory to the
- 17 department that the applicant:
- 18 <u>(1) is certified by a certifying entity as a</u>
- 19 registered dietitian or an equivalent certification;
- 20 (2) has met the education and experience requirements
- 21 for the registered dietitian standard or an equivalent standard
- 22 adopted by a certifying entity;
- 23 (3) has passed the examination given by the Commission
- 24 on Dietetic Registration, or an equivalent examination offered by a
- 25 <u>certifying entity, in dietetics;</u>
- 26 (4) is in compliance with all professional, ethical,
- 27 and disciplinary standards established by the certifying entity

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          SECTION 4. Sections 701.2575(a) and (b), Occupations Code,
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    are amended to read as follows:
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          (a) The department shall develop and administer [at least
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   twice each calendar year] a jurisprudence examination to determine
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    an applicant's knowledge of this chapter, commission rules under
    this chapter, and any other applicable laws of this state affecting
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    the applicant's dietetics practice.
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               In addition to the [license] examination required by
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    Section 701.2525 [701.253], an applicant must pass a jurisprudence
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    examination to qualify for a license under this chapter.
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          SECTION 5. Section 701.304, Occupations Code, is amended to
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    read as follows:
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          Sec. 701.304. GROUNDS FOR REFUSING RENEWAL. The commission
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    or department may refuse to renew the license of a person who fails
    to pay an administrative penalty imposed against the person under
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    Subchapter F, Chapter 51 [K], unless enforcement of the penalty is
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    stayed or a court has ordered that the administrative penalty is not

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         SECTION 7. (a)
                           The changes in law made by this Act to
   Subchapter F, Chapter 701, Occupations Code, apply only to an
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   application for a dietitian license submitted on or after January
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   1, 2024. An application for a dietitian license submitted before
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   January 1, 2024, is governed by the law in effect immediately before
   the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
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   effect for that purpose.
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          (b) A person who holds a dietitian license under Chapter
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   701, Occupations Code, on the effective date of this Act may
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   continue to renew that license without complying with Section
13
   701.2525, Occupations Code, as added by this Act.
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SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
