5	SECTION 1. Section 502.143, Transportation Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	Sec. 502.143. OTHER VEHICLES. <u>(a)</u> An owner may not register
8	the following vehicles for operation on a public highway:
9	<pre>(1) power sweepers;</pre>
10	<pre>(2) motorized mobility devices;</pre>
11	(3) electric personal assistive mobility devices;

13	(4) electric bicycles, as defined by Section 664.001;

15	(5) motor vehicles that are equipped with remote
16	vehicle disabling technology.
17	(b) For purposes of Subsection (a)(5), "remote vehicle
18	disabling technology" means any application or device, including
19	software, firmware, and hardware, that, when activated or engaged,
20	allows a person to disable the operation of a motor vehicle. The
21	term does not include an ignition interlock device as defined by
22	Article 42A.408, Code of Criminal Procedure.
23	SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 542, Transportation Code,
24	is amended by adding Section 542.502 to read as follows:

1 Sec. 542.502. MOTOR VEHICLE POWERED BY INTERNAL COMBUSTION ENGINE; OPERATION OF VEHICLE USING HUMAN DECISION-MAKING. A person 2 may not be prohibited from owning a motor vehicle that is powered by 3 4 an internal combustion engine or from operating that vehicle using human decision-making, regardless of any other law or regulation 5 6 requiring a motor vehicle to be equipped with or operated using an automated driving system, as defined by Section 545.451. 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 8
