- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.0051(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) County election precincts in a county with a population
- 8 of 250,000 or more may also be combined under Subsection (a) if the
- 9 changes result in county election precincts with 500 or more but
- 10 fewer than 5,000 [750] registered voters.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 43.007, Election Code, is amended by
- 12 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (q) to read as
- 13 follows:
- 14 (a) The secretary of state shall implement a program to
- 15 allow each commissioners court participating in the program to
- 16 [eliminate county election precinct polling places and] establish
- 17 countywide polling places at each county election precinct for:
- 18 (1) any election required to be conducted by the
- 19 county;
- 20 (2) any election held as part of a joint election
- 21 agreement with a county under Chapter 271;
- 22 (3) any election held under contract for election
- 23 services with a county under Subchapter D, Chapter 31;
- 24 (4) each primary election and runoff primary election

- 1 if:
- 2 (A) the county chair or county executive
- 3 committee of each political party participating in a joint primary
- 4 election under Section 172.126 agrees to the use of countywide
- 5 polling places; or
- 6 (B) the county chair or county executive
- 7 committee of each political party required to nominate candidates
- 8 by primary election agrees to use the same countywide polling
- 9 places; and
- 10 (5) each election of a political subdivision located
- 11 in the county that is held jointly with an election described by
- 12 Subdivision (3) or (4).
- 13 (q) Each countywide polling place must be provided with a
- 14 poll list for the entire county.
- SECTION 3. Sections 43.007(f), (g), (h), (m), and (n),
- 16 Election Code, are repealed.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
