2	(5) any person, if required by a court order;
3	(6) a federal, state, municipal, or county emergency
4	management authority, for the purpose of management or response to

6	(7) any person the executive director of the
7	commission considers appropriate, if:
8	(A) the executive director determines that:
9	(i) livestock may be threatened by a
10	disease, agent, or pest; and
