2 relating to the public sale of real property taken in execution of a

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4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 34.041, Civil Practice and Remedies

6 Code, is amended by adding Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsection

7 (b) to read as follows:

8 (a-1) The commissioners court of a county by official action

9 may authorize the officer charged with conducting a public sale of

10 real property taken in execution to conduct a public auction using

11 online bidding and sale. The commissioners court may adopt rules

12 governing online auctions authorized under this subsection. Rules

13 <u>adopted by the commissioners court under this subsection take</u>

effect on the 90th day after the date the rules are published in the

15 real property records of the county.

16 (b) The commissioners court of a county may designate an

area other than an area at the county courthouse where public sales

of real property under this chapter will take place that is in a

19 public place within a reasonable proximity of the county courthouse

20 as determined by the commissioners court and in a location as

21 accessible to the public as the courthouse door. The commissioners

22 court shall record that designation in the real property records of

23 the county. A designation by a commissioners court under this

24 section is not a ground for challenging or invalidating any

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- 1 sale. Except for a sale <u>conducted</u> under Subsection (a) <u>or (a-1)</u>, a
- 2 sale must be held at an area designated under this subsection if the
- 3 sale is held on or after the 90th day after the date the designation
- 4 is recorded. The commissioners court may by order authorize a
- 5 county official or employee to identify separate locations within
- 6 the designated area for the conduct of sales under this section and
- 7 for the conduct of sales by peace officers under other laws.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
