(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter,
the State Board of Education may adopt supplemental instructional
materials that are not on the list adopted under Section
31.023. The State Board of Education may adopt supplemental
instructional material under this section only if the instructional
material:

10 (1) contains material covering one or more primary 11 focal points or primary topics of a subject in the required 12 curriculum under Section 28.002, as determined by the State Board 13 of Education;

14 (2) is not designed to serve as the sole instructional15 material for a full course;

16 (3) meets applicable physical specifications adopted17 by the State Board of Education; <u>and</u>

18 (4) <u>complies with the standards under Section</u>
19 <u>31.023(b)</u> [is free from factual errors;

20 [(5) is suitable for the subject and grade level; and

21 [(6) is reviewed by academic experts in the subject
22 and grade level].

23 (a-1) If the State Board of Education determines that an 24 instructional material being considered for adoption under this 25 section contains content that does not comply with the standards 26 under Subsection (a), the board may not adopt the instructional 27 material unless the publisher removes the content or modifies the

1 content in a manner that complies with the standards under that 2 subsection.

SECTION 3. Sections 31.023 and 31.035, Education Code, as 3 4 amended by this Act, apply only to an instructional material list or supplemental instructional material adopted on or after the 5 6 effective date of this Act. An instructional material list or supplemental instructional material adopted before the effective 7 8 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the instructional material list or supplemental instructional material 9 was adopted, and the former law is continued in effect for that 10 purpose. 11
