(a) 10 In this section, "insurance restoration project" means work 11 performed to repair a home, business, or other structure following 12 a fire, a natural disaster, water damage, or mold damage and for 13 which the work is or will be compensated by insurance. 14 (b) Notwithstanding Section 95.003, a property owner is not 15 16 liable for personal injury or death to a contractor, subcontractor, or employee of a contractor or subcontractor arising from work on an 17 insurance restoration project if the contractor or subcontractor 18 does not maintain workers' compensation insurance coverage under 19 Chapter 406, Labor Code. 20 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of 22 23 this Act. 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
