A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT
relating to advanced air mobility technology.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

(Cook, Capriglione, Guerra, Bucy, Noble, et al.)

4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 21, Transportation Code,

5 is amended by adding Section 21.0045 to read as follows:

6 Sec. 21.0045. ADVANCED AIR MOBILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

- 7 (a) In this section, "advanced air mobility" has the meaning
- 8 assigned by Section 21.072.

By:

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- 9 (b) The commission shall appoint an advisory committee to
- 10 assess current state law and any potential changes to state law that
- 11 are needed to facilitate the implementation of advanced air
- 12 mobility technology in this state.
- (c) The commission shall appoint to the advisory committee
- 14 members to represent:
- 15 (1) diverse geographic regions of the state;
- 16 (2) state and local law enforcement;
- 17 (3) the advanced air mobility industry;
- 18 (4) transportation experts;
- 19 (5) commercial airport representatives;
- 20 (6) vertical takeoff and landing operators and
- 21 <u>vertiport operators;</u>
- 22 <u>(7) local governments; and</u>
- 23 (8) the general public.
- 24 (d) The advisory committee shall:

- 1 (1) hold public hearings in locations across the state
- 2 or via electronic means; and
- 3 (2) receive comments through an Internet website, by
- 4 mail, and by other methods, if appropriate.
- 5 (e) Not later than November 1, 2024, the advisory committee
- 6 shall submit to the commission and the legislature a written report
- 7 that includes the committee's findings and recommendations on any
- 8 changes to state law that are needed to facilitate the
- 9 implementation of advanced air mobility technology in this state.
- 10 (f) The advisory committee is abolished and this section
- 11 expires January 1, 2025.
- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Transportation Code,
- 13 is amended by adding Section 21.072 to read as follows:
- Sec. 21.072. ADVANCED AIR MOBILITY. (a) In this section,
- 15 "advanced air mobility" means an aviation transportation system
- 16 that uses highly automated aircraft, which may be manned or
- 17 unmanned, to operate and transport passengers or cargo at lower
- 18 altitudes for commercial, public service, private, or recreational
- 19 purposes.
- 20 (b) The department shall:
- 21 (1) review existing state aviation standards and
- 22 guidelines, airport facility planning, and compatibility guidance
- 23 to ensure that the standards, guidelines, planning, and guidance
- 24 are applicable to advanced air mobility;
- 25 (2) support the development of federal and industry
- 26 standards for advanced air mobility technology that prioritize
- 27 safety as the technology develops;

- 1 (3) designate a department employee as a liaison to
- 2 the Federal Aviation Administration for purposes of Subdivision
- 3 (2);
- 4 (4) develop a statewide plan, or an update to the Texas
- 5 Airport System Plan, that specifies potential locations for and
- 6 classifications of vertiports and other associated infrastructure
- 7 to guide the future operational environment of advanced air
- 8 mobility; and
- 9 <u>(5) provide resources and assistance on the use of</u>
- 10 advanced air mobility technology and infrastructure to local
- 11 governments, regional councils of government, transportation
- 12 planning organizations, the advanced air mobility industry, and
- 13 other entities for the purpose of identifying governmental methods
- 14 to integrate industry innovation and community vision and help
- 15 promote advanced air mobility technology.
- 16 (c) The department, Texas Education Agency, Texas Higher
- 17 Education Coordinating Board, and Texas State Technical College
- 18 System shall jointly collaborate with school districts,
- 19 institutions of higher education, and interested public and private
- 20 stakeholders on educational opportunities related to advanced air
- 21 mobility technology.
- 22 SECTION 3. The Texas Department of Transportation, Texas
- 23 Education Agency, Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, and
- 24 Texas State Technical College System are required to implement
- 25 Section 21.072, Transportation Code, as added by this Act, only if
- 26 the legislature appropriates money specifically for that purpose.
- 27 If the legislature does not appropriate money specifically for that

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- 1 purpose, the Texas Department of Transportation, Texas Education
- 2 Agency, Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, and Texas State
- 3 Technical College System may, but are not required to, implement
- 4 Section 21.072, Transportation Code, using other appropriations
- 5 available for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
