## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to boycott, coercion, and intimidation activities by
- 3 insurance companies regarding environmental, social, and
- 4 governance matters.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 541.054, Insurance Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 541.054. BOYCOTT, COERCION, OR INTIMIDATION. (a) It
- 9 is an unfair method of competition or an unfair or deceptive act or
- 10 practice in the business of insurance to commit through concerted
- 11 action or to enter into an agreement to commit an act of boycott,
- 12 coercion, or intimidation that results in or tends to result in the
- 13 unreasonable restraint of or a monopoly in the business of
- 14 insurance.
- 15 (b) An act of boycott, coercion, or intimidation includes
- 16 refusing to deal with, terminating business activities with, or
- 17 otherwise taking any commercial action that is intended to
- 18 penalize, inflict economic harm on, limit commercial relations
- 19 with, or change or limit the activities of a company because the
- 20 company, without violating controlling federal or state law:
- (1) engages in the exploration, production,
- 22 utilization, transportation, sale, or manufacturing of fossil
- 23 <u>fuel-based energy, timber, mining, or agriculture;</u>
- 24 (2) engages in, facilitates, or supports the

- 1 manufacture, import, distribution, marketing or advertising, sale,
- 2 or lawful use of firearms, ammunition, or component parts and
- 3 accessories of firearms or ammunition;
- 4 (3) contracts with the United States Immigration and
- 5 Customs Enforcement for the provision of federal immigration
- 6 <u>detention centers or support services related to the implementation</u>
- 7 of federal immigration and border security laws, regulations, and
- 8 policies;
- 9 (4) does not meet, is not expected to meet, or does not
- 10 commit to meet environmental standards or disclosure criteria, in
- 11 particular to eliminate, reduce, offset, or disclose greenhouse gas
- 12 emissions; or
- 13 (5) does not meet, is not expected to meet, or does not
- 14 commit to meet corporate board, employment, composition,
- 15 compensation, or disclosure criteria that incorporates
- 16 characteristics protected under Chapter 21, Labor Code.
- 17 (c) A method of competition, act, or practice in the
- 18 business of insurance may be determined to be an action to boycott,
- 19 coerce, or intimidate based on evidence indicating that purpose,
- 20 including:
- 21 (1) branding, advertising, statements, explanations,
- 22 reports, letters to clients, communications with portfolio
- 23 companies, statements of principles, or commitments; or
- 24 (2) participation in, affiliation with, or status as a
- 25 signatory to any coalition, initiative, joint statement of
- 26 principles, or agreement.
- 27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
