- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 54, Water Code, is amended
- 13 by adding Section 54.0135 to read as follows:
- Sec. 54.0135. PRE-PETITION NOTICE TO CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a)
- 15 This section applies only to a proposed district described by
- 16 Section 54.0161(a).
- 17 (b) Before a petition requesting creation of a proposed
- 18 district is filed with the commission under Section 54.014, notice
- 19 <u>must be sent by certified mail to the commissioners court of each</u>
- 20 county in which the proposed district is to be located. The notice
- 21 <u>must:</u>
- 22 (1) generally describe the boundaries of the land to
- 23 be included in the proposed district, including, if possible, by
- 24 metes and bounds or by lot and block number if there is a recorded

map or plat and survey of the area to be included in the district; 1 2 and 3 (2) inform the commissioners court of the right to: (A) respond to the notice provided under this 4 5 section; 6 (B) review the petition requesting creation of 7 the proposed district; and (C) submit a written opinion on the creation of 8 9 the proposed district under Section 54.0161. 10 (c) Notice under this section must be sent by certified mail at least 30 days before the date a petition requesting creation of 11 the proposed district is filed with the commission under Section 12 13 54.014. SECTION 3. Section 54.015, Water Code, is amended to read as 14 15 follows: 16 Sec. 54.015. CONTENTS OF PETITION. The petition shall: 17 (1) describe the boundaries of the proposed district by metes and bounds or by lot and block number, if there is a 18 recorded map or plat and survey of the area; 19 20 state the general nature of the work proposed to be done, the necessity for the work, and the cost of the project as 21 then estimated by those filing the petition; [and] 22 (3) include a name of the district which shall be 23 generally descriptive of the locale of the district followed by the 24 words Municipal Utility District, or if a district is located 25 within one county, it may be designated "\_\_\_ 26 Municipal Utility District No. \_\_\_\_\_." (Insert the name of the 27

- 1 county and proper consecutive number.) The proposed district shall
- 2 not have the same name as any other district in the same county; and
- 3 (4) for a district described by Section 54.0161,
- 4 include a copy of the notice described by Section 54.0135.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 54.0135, Water Code, as added by this
- 6 Act, and Section 54.015, Water Code, as amended by this Act, apply
- 7 only to the creation of a municipal utility district on or after the
- 8 effective date of this Act. A petition requesting creation of a
- 9 municipal utility district pending before the Texas Commission on
- 10 Environmental Quality on the effective date of this Act is governed
- 11 by the law in effect on the date the petition was filed, and the
- 12 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
