1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to public acknowledgment of donations made to the Texas
 1-20 Department of Transportation.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 201.206, Transportation Code, is amended
 1-23 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 201.206. DONATIONS AND CONTRIBUTIONS. (a) For the
 1-25 purpose of carrying out its functions and duties, the department
 1-26 may accept, from any source, a donation or contribution in any form,
 1-27 including realty, personalty, money, materials, or services.

1-28 (b) The department may enter into an agreement with a donor
 1-29 to publicly acknowledge donations made to the department. The
 1-30 public acknowledgment may not contain comparative or qualitative
 1-31 descriptions of the donor's products, services, facilities, or
 1-32 companies.

1-33 (c) If a person makes a donation to the department's
 1-34 roadside assistance and safety service patrol program, the
 1-35 department may post an acknowledgment of the donation on a vehicle
 1-36 or equipment the department uses for the program.

1-37 (d) The commission may adopt rules for the acknowledgment of
 1-38 donations under this section.

1-39 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-40 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-41 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-42 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-43 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
