## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the venue for the prosecution of an election offense.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 13, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 5 amended by adding Article 13.41 to read as follows:
- 6 Art. 13.41. ELECTION OFFENSES. (a) An offense classified
- 7 as a felony under the Election Code, or a felony offense otherwise
- 8 related to an election conducted in this state, may be prosecuted in
- 9 <u>a judicial district adjoining the judicial district in which the</u>
- 10 offense occurred.

- 11 (b) An offense classified as a misdemeanor under the
- 12 Election Code, or a misdemeanor offense otherwise related to an
- 13 election conducted in this state, may be prosecuted in a county
- 14 adjoining the county in which the offense occurred.
- 15 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 16 a violation of law that occurs on or after the effective date of
- 17 this Act. A violation that occurs before the effective date of this
- 18 Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the violation
- 19 occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 20 purpose. For purposes of this section, a violation of law occurred
- 21 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the
- 22 violation occurred before that date.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
