4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 21.04892 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 21.04892. DUAL LANGUAGE IMMERSION BILINGUAL EDUCATION
8	CERTIFICATION. (a) The board shall establish a dual language
9	immersion bilingual education teaching certificate to provide
10	instruction to high school students in bilingual education programs
11	using a dual language immersion/one-way or two-way program model.
12	(b) To be eligible for a certificate established under this
13	section, a person must:
14	(1) satisfactorily complete the coursework for that
15	certificate in an educator preparation program;
16	(2) perform satisfactorily on the Bilingual Target
17	Language Proficiency Test; and
18	(3) satisfy any other requirements prescribed by the
19	board designed to address specific linguistic and content
20	requirements for effective instruction in a dual language immersion
21	program.
22	(c) The board shall propose rules to allow a person seeking
23	certification under this section who fails to perform
24	satisfactorily on the Bilingual Target Language Proficiency Test

2	(1) retake only the sections of the test that include
3	the domains on which the person failed to perform satisfactorily;
4	and
5	(2) during a retake of the test described by
6	Subdivision (1), demonstrate the person's language proficiency
7	through the completion of fewer components, including eliminating a
8	component that requires the preparation of a lesson plan for a
9	person who fails to perform satisfactorily on a domain requiring
10	completion of that component.
11	SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
12	of this Act, the State Board for Educator Certification shall
13	propose rules prescribing requirements for an educator
14	certification in dual language immersion bilingual education
15	teaching as provided by Section 21.04892, Education Code, as added
16	by this Act.

17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
