5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 407A, Labor Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 407A.0521 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 407A.0521. NEW CERTIFICATES OF APPROVAL PROHIBITED.
9	(a) Notwithstanding Section 407A.052, the commissioner may not
10	issue a certificate of approval to a proposed group on or after
11	September 1, 2023.
12	(b) The commissioner may amend a certificate of approval
13	issued to a group before September 1, 2023.
14	SECTION 2. Subchapter J, Chapter 407A, Labor Code, is
15	amended by adding Section 407A.4561 to read as follows:
16	Sec. 407A.4561. REVISED PLAN OF OPERATION: WIND DOWN. (a)
17	In this section, "qualified group" means a group that:
18	(1) holds a current certificate of approval under this
19	chapter; and
20	(2) has not been determined by the commissioner to be
21	insolvent under Section 407A.355.
22	(b) The board shall submit to the commissioner for approval
23	a revised plan of operation to wind down and dissolve the guaranty
24	fund and trust fund. The plan must include:

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1	(1) steps for:
2	(A) distributing any remaining money in the
3	guaranty fund and trust fund to qualified groups; and
4	(B) notifying interested parties; and
5	(2) an estimated timeline for the wind down.
6	(c) The commissioner shall approve the board's revised plan
7	of operation if the commissioner determines that the plan
8	sufficiently describes the actions the board will take to wind down
9	and dissolve the guaranty fund and trust fund.
10	(d) The board shall:
11	(1) implement the revised plan of operation approved
12	under Subsection (b); and
13	(2) provide written notice to the commissioner of the
14	completion of the wind down not later than the 30th day after the
15	date of completion.
16	(e) Not later than the 30th day after the date the
17	commissioner receives the board's notice under Subsection (d), the
18	commissioner shall determine whether the guaranty fund has met its
19	obligations under the approved revised plan of operation. If the
20	commissioner determines that the guaranty fund met the fund's
21	obligations, the commissioner shall issue an order requiring the
22	distribution of any remaining money in the guaranty fund and trust
23	fund to qualified groups.
24	(f) On the 30th day after the date the commissioner issues
25	the order under Subsection (e):
26	(1) the guaranty fund and the trust fund are
27	dissolved; and

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(2) the board is abolished.

SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2023, the board of 2 directors of the Texas self-insurance group guaranty fund shall 3 submit the revised plan of operation to the commissioner of 4 5 insurance required by Section 407A.4561, Labor Code, as added by 6 this Act.

7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
