1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-23 relating to the sale of distilled spirits to ultimate consumers by 1-24 the holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Sections 14.05(c) and (f), Alcoholic Beverage Code, are amended to read as follows:

(c) The holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit may not under Subsection (b) sell more than $\underline{\text{four}}$ [two] 750 milliliter bottles of distilled spirits or the equivalent to the same consumer within a 30-day period.
