S.B. No. 2290

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to requiring a venue for sexually oriented performances to provide certain content warnings.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 17, Business & Commerce Code, is amended by adding Subchapter M to read as follows:

SUBCHAPTER M. NOTICE REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN ADULT ORIENTED  
BUSINESSES

Sec. 17.975. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:

(1) "Sexually oriented performance" means a visual performance that appeals to the prurient interest by:

(A) featuring a performer who is nude, as defined by Section 102.051, Business & Commerce Code; or

(B) featuring a male performer that exhibits as a female or a female performer that exhibits as a male using clothing, makeup, or other physical markers and signs, lip syncs, dances, or otherwise performs before an audience for entertainment.

(2) "Sexually oriented performance venue" means a nightclub, bar, restaurant, or other commercial enterprise that provides for an audience of two or more individuals a sexually oriented performance.

Sec. 17.976. CONTENT WARNING REQUIRED. A sexually oriented performance venue shall:

(1) post in a prominent place by each public entrance a

1 sign conspicuously warning prospective patrons of the type and  
2 content of the scheduled sexually oriented performance, including  
3 whether the performance contains sexual content; and

4 (2) include the warning in any advertisement for the  
5 performance, including any advertisement that appears on a social  
6 media website.

7 Sec. 17.977. DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICE. A violation of  
8 Section 17.976 is a deceptive trade practice under Subchapter E,  
9 Chapter 17, and is actionable under that subchapter.

10 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2024, a sexually  
11 oriented performance venue shall comply with Subchapter M, Chapter  
12 17, Business & Commerce Code, as amended by this Act.

13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
