A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to service requirements of certain current or former
- 3 members of the Texas National Guard, the Texas Air National Guard,
- 4 or a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States for
- 5 tuition and fee exemptions at public institutions of higher
- 6 education.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 54.341(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 (a) The governing board of each institution of higher
- 11 education shall exempt the following persons from the payment of
- 12 tuition, dues, fees, and other required charges, including fees for
- 13 correspondence courses but excluding general deposit fees, student
- 14 services fees, and any fees or charges for lodging, board, or
- 15 clothing, provided the person seeking the exemption currently
- 16 resides in this state and entered the service at a location in this
- 17 state, declared this state as the person's home of record in the
- 18 manner provided by the applicable military or other service, or
- 19 would have been determined to be a resident of this state for
- 20 purposes of Subchapter B at the time the person entered the service:
- 21 (1) all nurses and honorably discharged members of the
- 22 armed forces of the United States who served during the
- 23 Spanish-American War or during World War I;
- 24 (2) all nurses, members of the Women's Army Auxiliary

- 1 Corps, members of the Women's Auxiliary Volunteer Emergency
- 2 Service, and all honorably discharged members of the armed forces
- 3 of the United States who served during World War II except those who
- 4 were discharged from service because they were over the age of 38 or
- 5 because of a personal request on the part of the person that the
- 6 person be discharged from service;
- 7 (3) all honorably discharged men and women of the
- 8 armed forces of the United States who served during the national
- 9 emergency which began on June 27, 1950, and which is referred to as
- 10 the Korean War; [and]
- 11 (4) all persons who were honorably discharged from the
- 12 armed forces of the United States after serving on active military
- 13 duty, excluding training, for more than 180 days and who served a
- 14 portion of their active duty during:
- 15 (A) the Cold War which began on the date of the
- 16 termination of the national emergency cited in Subdivision (3);
- 17 (B) the Vietnam era which began on December 21,
- 18 1961, and ended on May 7, 1975;
- 19 (C) the Grenada and Lebanon era which began on
- 20 August 24, 1982, and ended on July 31, 1984;
- (D) the Panama era which began on December 20,
- 22 1989, and ended on January 21, 1990;
- (E) the Persian Gulf War which began on August 2,
- 24 1990, and ends on the date thereafter prescribed by Presidential
- 25 proclamation or September 1, 1997, whichever occurs first;
- 26 (F) the national emergency by reason of certain
- 27 terrorist attacks that began on September 11, 2001; or

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- 1 (G) any future national emergency declared in
- 2 accordance with federal law; and
- 3 (5) all persons not otherwise described by Subdivision
- 4 (4) who were honorably discharged from a reserve component of the
- 5 armed forces of the United States, the Texas National Guard, or the
- 6 Texas Air National Guard after serving for a continuous period of at
- 7 <u>least 20 years in the applicable military service</u>.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
