8	BOARDS. (a) This section applies only to a metropolitan planning
9	organization that serves a county with a population of more than

12	described by Subsection (a) shall appoint voting members to the
13	organization's policy board as follows:
14	(1) a county with a population of four million or more
15	shall appoint two members;
16	(2) a county with a population of less than four
17	million but more than 45,000 shall appoint one member; and
18	(3) a county with a population of 45,000 or less,
19	together with an adjacent county with a population of 45,000 or

- 11 (f) A port authority located in a municipality with a
- 12 population of more than two million that is served by a metropolitan
- 13 planning organization described by Subsection (a) shall appoint one
- 14 voting member to the organization's policy board.
- 15 (g) The governor shall appoint two voting members to the
- 16 policy board of a metropolitan planning organization described by
- 17 Subsection (a).
- (h) Each member of a policy board of a metropolitan planning
- 19 organization described by Subsection (a) is entitled to one vote.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
