- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 161.125, Utilities Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 161.125. EMINENT DOMAIN. (a) An electric cooperative
- 8 may exercise the power of eminent domain in the manner provided by
- 9 state law for acquiring private property for public use. The power
- 10 does not apply to state property or property of a political
- 11 subdivision in this state.

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- 12 (b) An electric cooperative may not exercise the power of
- 13 eminent domain to acquire an interest in real property to drill,
- 14 mine, or produce from that property oil, gas, geothermal resources,
- 15 geothermal/geopressured resources, or lignite, coal, sulphur,
- 16 uranium, plutonium, or other minerals that belong to another person
- 17 regardless of whether the material is in place or is in the process
- 18 of being drilled, mined, or produced.
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to the acquisition of real property in connection with an initial
- 21 offer made under Section 21.0113, Property Code, on or after the
- 22 effective date of this Act. An acquisition of real property in
- 23 connection with an initial offer made under Section 21.0113,
- 24 Property Code, before the effective date of this Act is governed by

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- 1 the law applicable to the acquisition immediately before the
- 2 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 3 that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
