4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 8, Insurance Code, is amended
6	by adding Chapter 1462 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 1462. UNCONDITIONAL DESIGNATION AS PREFERRED
8	PROVIDER
9	Sec. 1462.001 DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1)"Managed care plan" means a health benefit plan under
11	which health care services are provided to enrollees through
12	contracts with physicians and that requires enrollees to use
13	participating physicians or that provides a different level of
14	coverage for enrollees who use participating physicians. The term
15	includes a health benefit plan issued by:
16	(A) a health maintenance organization;
17	(B) a preferred provider benefit plan issuer; or
18	(C) any other entity that issues a health benefit
19	plan, including an insurance company.
20	(2) "Participating physician" means a physician who has
21	directly or indirectly contracted with a health benefit plan issuer
22	to provide services to enrollees.
23	(3)"Physician" means an individual licensed to practice
24	medicine in this state. The term does not include an individual

holding a license to practice administrative medicine under Section 1 2 155.009, Occupations Code. Sec. 1462.002. APPLICABILITY (a) 3 OF CHAPTER. 4 Notwithstanding any other law, this chapter applies to: 5 (1) a basic coverage plan under Chapter 1551; (2) a basic plan under Chapter 1575; 6 7 (3) a primary care coverage plan under Chapter 1579; 8 and 9 (4) a basic coverage under Chapter 1601. (b) Notwithstanding any other law, this chapter applies to 10 11 coverage under: (1) the child health plan program under Chapter 62, Health 12 13 and Safety Code; and 14 (2) a Medicaid managed care program operated under Chapter 15 533, Government Code. 16 Sec. 1462.003. UNCONDITIONAL DESIGNATION AS PARTICIPATING PHYSICIAN. Notwithstanding any other law, any physician may apply 17 for a designation as a participating provider in a managed care 18 plan, and the managed care plan issuer or administrator shall 19 20 designate the physician as a participating physician in the plan. Sec. 1462.004. REQUIRED REIMBURSEMENT RATE. A managed care 21 plan shall reimburse a participating physician designated under 22 Section 1462.003 at a rate 90% of the highest contracted rated for 23 24 the same service. 25 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act

26 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 27 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,

1 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 2 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 3 waiver or authorization is granted.

4 SECTION 3. Chapter 1462, Insurance Code, as added by this 5 Act, applies only to a health benefit plan delivered, issued for 6 delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2024.

7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
