- 5 SECTION 1. Section 86.002, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (d-1) and amending Subsection (g) to read as

- 8 (d-1) The secretary of state shall prescribe instructions
- 9 to be printed on the balloting materials for marking the ballot
- 10 envelope with the information required under Subsection (g). The
- 11 instructions must:
- 12 (1) be printed in at least a 10-point font;
- 13 (2) not include the text "V.U.I.D." next to the space
- 14 for the ID number and
- 15 (3) contain the statement: A voter registration
- 16 number (V.U.I.D.) does not satisfy the requirement and should not
- 17 be printed on the carrier envelope."
- 18 (g) The carrier envelope must include a space, at least one
- 19 <u>half inch in height and two inches in width</u>, that is hidden from
- 20 view when the envelope is sealed for the voter to enter the
- 21 following information:
- (1) the number of the voter's driver's license,
- 23 election identification certificate, or personal identification
- 24 card issued by the Department of Public Safety;

- 1 (2) if the voter has not been issued a number described
- 2 by Subdivision (1), the last four digits of the voter's social
- 3 security number; or
- 4 (3) a statement by the applicant that the applicant
- 5 has not been issued a number described by Subdivision (1) or (2).
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
