- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 61.002(c), Election Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (c) Immediately after closing the polls for voting on
- 7 election day and on the last day of early voting by personal
- 8 appearance, the presiding election judge or alternate election
- 9 judge shall print the tape to show the number of votes cast for each
- 10 candidate or ballot measure for each voting machine.
- SECTION 2. Sections 85.001(a) and (c), Election Code, are
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) The period for early voting by personal appearance
- 14 begins on the eighth [17th] day before election day and continues
- 15 through the [fourth] day before election day, except as otherwise
- 16 provided by this section.
- 17 (c) If the date prescribed by Subsection (a) [or (b)] for
- 18 beginning the period is a Saturday, Sunday, or legal state holiday,
- 19 the early voting period begins on the next regular business day.
- SECTION 3. Section 85.033, Election Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- Sec. 85.033. SECURITY OF VOTING MACHINE. (a) At the close
- 23 of early voting each day, the early voting clerk shall secure each
- 24 voting machine used for early voting in the manner prescribed by the

- 1 secretary of state so that its unauthorized operation is prevented.
- 2 The clerk shall unsecure the machine before the beginning of early
- 3 voting the following day.
- 4 (b) To the extent possible, closing and securing of voting
- 5 machines shall be done in the same manner as required by provisions
- 6 of this code pertaining to election day.
- 7 SECTION 4. Sections 85.001(b) and (e), Election Code, are
- 8 repealed.
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
