- 14 services under a Medicaid waiver program established under Section
- 1915(c), Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. Section 1396n(c)). 15
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 17 school year.

- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 19
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 20
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 22
