8	Code, is amended by adding Chapter 7994A to read as follows:	
9	CHAPTER 7994A. OPEN R FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT OF CALDWELL

11	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS	
12	Sec. 7994A.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:	
13	(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.	
14	(2) "Director" means a board member.	
15	(3) "District" means the Open R Fresh Water Supply	
16	District of Caldwell County.	
17	Sec. 7994A.0102. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a	
18	municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI,	
19	Texas Constitution.	
20	Sec. 7994A.0103. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT.	
21	(a) The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit.	
22	(b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of:	
23	(1) a municipal utility district as provided by	
24	general law and Section 59 Article XVI Texas Constitution, and	

- 1 (2) Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that
- 2 relate to the construction, acquisition, improvement, operation,
- 3 or maintenance of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or
- 4 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.
- 5 Sec. 7994A.0104. DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The district is
- 6 composed of the territory described by Section 2 of the Act enacting
- 7 this chapter.
- 8 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
- 9 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the
- 10 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
- 11 does not affect the district's:
- 12 (1) organization, existence, or validity;
- 13 (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes
- 14 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and
- 15 interest on a bond;
- 16 (3) right to impose a tax; or
- 17 <u>(4) legality or operation.</u>
- SUBCHAPTER B. POWERS AND DUTIES
- 19 Sec. 7994A.0201. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district
- 20 has the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for
- 21 which the district is created.
- 22 <u>Sec. 7994A.0202. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND</u>
- 23 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the
- 24 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,
- 25 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59,
- 26 Article XVI, Texas Constitution.
- Sec. 7994A.0203. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. Under

- 1 Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may
- 2 design, acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve,
- 3 operate, maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a
- 4 municipality for operation and maintenance macadamized, graveled,
- 5 or paved roads, or improvements, including storm drainage, and
- 6 landscaping, in aid of those roads.
- 7 Sec. 7994A.0204. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A
- 8 road project must meet all applicable construction standards,
- 9 zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulations of each
- 10 municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial
- 11 jurisdiction the road project is located.
- 12 (b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits
- 13 or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the road
- 14 project must meet all applicable construction standards,
- 15 subdivision requirements, and regulations of each county in which
- 16 the road project is located.
- (c) If the state will maintain and operate the road, the
- 18 Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and
- 19 specifications of the road project.
- 20 SUBCHAPTER C. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS
- Sec. 7994A.0301. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS. (a)
- 22 The district may issue, without an election, bonds and other
- 23 <u>obligations secured by:</u>
- 24 <u>(1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes; or</u>
- 25 (2) contract payments described by Section
- 26 7994A.0303.
- 27 (b) The district must hold an election in the manner

- 1 provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval
- 2 before the district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds
- 3 payable from ad valorem taxes.
- 4 (c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem
- 5 taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a
- 6 vote of a two-thirds majority of the district voters voting at an
- 7 <u>election held for that purpose.</u>
- 8 Sec. 7994A.0302. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
- 9 authorized at an election held under Section 7994A.0301, the
- 10 district may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable
- 11 property in the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water
- 12 Code.
- 13 (b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
- 14 exceed the rate approved at the election.
- 15 Sec. 7994A.0303. CONTRACT TAXES. (a) In accordance with
- 16 Section 49.108, Water Code, the district may impose a tax other than
- 17 <u>an operation and maintenance tax and use the revenue derived from</u>
- 18 the tax to make payments under a contract after the provisions of
- 19 the contract have been approved by a majority of the district voters
- 20 voting at an election held for that purpose.
- 21 (b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a
- 22 provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by
- 23 the board without further voter approval.
- SUBCHAPTER D. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS
- Sec. 7994A.0401. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER
- 26 OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations
- 27 payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees,

- 1 revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any
- 2 combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district
- 3 purpose.
- 4 Sec. 7994A.0402. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district
- 5 issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the
- 6 board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing
- 7 direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all
- 8 or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner
- 9 provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code.
- Sec. 7994A.0403. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of
- 11 issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations
- 12 issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad
- 13 valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the
- 14 real property in the district.
- 15 SECTION 2. The Open R Fresh Water Supply District of

- 24 CONTAINING a computed area of 1,278.22 acres or 55,679,090 square
- 25 feet of land, more or less.
- SECTION 3. (a) All governmental and proprietary actions
- 27 and proceedings of the Open R Fresh Water Supply District of

- 1 Caldwell County taken before the effective date of this Act are
- 2 validated, ratified, and confirmed in all respects as of the dates
- 3 on which they occurred.
- 4 (b) This section does not apply to any matter that on the
- 5 effective date of this Act:
- 6 (1) is involved in litigation if the litigation
- 7 ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final court
- 8 judgment; or
- 9 (2) has been held invalid by a final court judgment.
- 10 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 11 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 12 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 13 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 14 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 15 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 16 Government Code.
- 17 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 18 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 19 Environmental Quality.
- 20 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 21 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 22 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 23 representatives within the required time.
- 24 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 25 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 26 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 27 and accomplished.

- 1 SECTION 5. (a) If this Act does not receive a two-thirds
- 2 vote of all the members elected to each house, Subchapter B, Chapter
- 3 7994A, Special District Local Laws Code, as added by Section 1 of
- 4 this Act, is amended by adding Section 7994A.0205 to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 Sec. 7994A.0205. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may
- 7 not exercise the power of eminent domain.
- 8 (b) This section is not intended to be an expression of a
- 9 legislative interpretation of the requirements of Section 17(c),
- 10 Article I, Texas Constitution.
- 11 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
