## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the prosecution of the offense of official oppression.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 39.03, Penal Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsections (a) and (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (a) A public servant acting under color of the public
- 8 <u>servant's</u> [his] office or employment commits an offense if the
- 9 public servant [he]:
- 10 (1) intentionally subjects another to mistreatment or
- 11 to arrest, detention, search, seizure, dispossession, assessment,
- 12 or lien that the public servant [he] knows is unlawful;
- 13 (2) intentionally denies or impedes another in the
- 14 exercise or enjoyment of any right, privilege, power, or immunity,
- 15 knowing the public servant's [his] conduct is unlawful; [or]
- 16 (3) intentionally subjects another to sexual
- 17 harassment; or
- 18 (4) directly provides an alcoholic beverage to a
- 19 <u>legislative employee or intern who is younger than 21 years of age</u>.
- 20 (d) An offense under Subsection (a)(1), (2), or (3) [this
- 21 section] is a Class A misdemeanor, except that the [an] offense is a
- 22 felony of the third degree if the public servant acted with the
- 23 intent to impair the accuracy of data reported to the Texas
- 24 Education Agency through the Public Education Information

- 1 Management System (PEIMS) described by Sections 48.008 and 48.009,
- 2 Education Code, under a law requiring that reporting.
- 3 (e) An offense under Subsection (a)(4) is a Class A
- 4 <u>misdemeanor with a term of confinement of one year.</u>
- 5 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 6 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 7 Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 8 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 9 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 10 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 11 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 12 before that date.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
