1 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 2 WHEREAS, The National Life Monument celebrates the miracle of life and the women at the center of that miracle; and 3 4 WHEREAS, Sculpted by artist Timothy Schmalz, the bronze sculpture depicts a mother with an unborn child cradled in a 5 world-shaped womb; and 6 7 WHEREAS, The eight-foot bronze statue was permanently installed at the Church of San Marcello al Corso in Rome in May 8 2022, and after a tour of the U.S., the original Life Monument was 9 installed at the Theological College in Washington, D.C.; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Under Chapter 443, Government Code, and rules of the State Preservation Board, a portion of the north Capitol grounds is 12 available for new monuments, subject to legislative approval, 13 specified procedural requirements, the provision of funding from 14 private donors, conformity to certain size and design limitations 15 16 and parameters, and completion on a timely basis; and 17 WHEREAS, A replica of the monument on the Capitol grounds would provide a communal place for Texans to celebrate the beauty of 18 human life; now, therefore, be it 19 20 RESOLVED, That the 88th Legislature of the State of Texas

hereby authorize the State Preservation Board, subject to state law

and rules of the board, to approve the construction of a replica of

the National Life Monument at the State Capitol Complex, at a site

outside of the historic Capitol grounds; and, be it further
