- 15 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) The constitutional amendment
- 16 proposed by the 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023, abolishing
- 17 the office of County Treasurer in Galveston County takes effect
- 18 only if, at the statewide election at which the amendment is
- 19 submitted to and approved by the voters, a majority of the voters of
- 20 Galveston County voting on the question at that election also favor
- 21 the amendment. The amendment takes effect January 1, 2024, if the
- 22 conditions of this subsection are met.
- 23 (b) This temporary provision expires January 2, 2024.
- SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be

- 1 submitted to the voters at an election to be held on November 7,
- 2 2023. The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against
- 3 the proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the
- 4 abolition of the office of county treasurer in Galveston County."
