2	proposing a constitutional amendment clarifying that a voter must

4	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1(a), Article VI, Texas Constitution, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) The following classes of persons shall not be allowed to
8	vote in this State:
9	(1) persons under 18 years of age;
10	(2) persons who have been determined mentally
11	incompetent by a court, subject to such exceptions as the
12	Legislature may make; [and]
13	(3) persons convicted of any felony, subject to such
14	exceptions as the Legislature may make; and
15	(4) persons who are not citizens of the United States.
16	SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
17	submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
18	The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
19	proposition: "The constitutional amendment clarifying that a voter
20	must be a United States citizen."
