- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1(a), Article VI, Texas Constitution, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The following classes of persons shall not be allowed to
- 8 vote in this State:
- 9 (1) persons under 18 years of age;
- 10 (2) persons who have been determined mentally
- 11 incompetent by a court, subject to such exceptions as the
- 12 Legislature may make; [and]
- 13 (3) persons convicted of any felony, subject to such
- 14 exceptions as the Legislature may make; and
- 15 (4) persons who are not citizens of the United States.
- 16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment clarifying that a voter
- 20 must be a United States citizen."
