- 6 SECTION 1. Article V, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 1-b to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 1-b. The authorship of an opinion published by a court
- 9 is public information. A court may not issue a per curiam decision.
- 10 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 11 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 12 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 13 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to prohibit a court
- 14 from issuing an opinion without disclosing the judge who authored
- 15 the opinion."
