A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to consider legislation on any subject during a special session.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 40, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 40. (a) When the legislature is [Legislature shall be]
- 7 convened in \underline{a} special session, $\underline{the legislature may consider}$ [there
- 8 shall be no] legislation on any subject, including the [upon]
- 9 subjects [other than those] designated in the proclamation of the
- 10 governor [Governor] calling the [such] session, or presented to the
- 11 legislature [them] by the governor.
- 12 <u>(b) No special</u> [Governor; and no such] session shall be of
- 13 longer duration than thirty days.
- 14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 15 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 18 legislature to consider legislation on any subject during a special
- 19 session."
