The governing body of a county or municipality may 9 10 exempt from ad valorem taxation all or part of the appraised value 11 of real property used to operate a child-care facility. governing body may adopt the exemption as a percentage of the 12 appraised value of the real property. The percentage specified by 13 the governing body may not be less than 50 percent. The legislature 14 15 by general law may define "child-care facility" for purposes of this section and may provide additional eligibility requirements 16 for the exemption authorized by this section. 17 SECTION 2.
