S.J.R. No. 66

A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment guaranteeing the right of
2 individuals to refuse medical treatments and to access public
3 accommodations.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by
6 adding Section 36 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 36. RIGHT TO REFUSE MEDICAL TREATMENT; ACCESS TO
8 PUBLIC ACCOMMODATIONS. (a) Each individual residing in this state
9 has the right to refuse any medical treatment, including a
10 procedure, vaccine, medical device, or prophylactic, and a person
11 may not interfere with or impede that right in any manner.

12 (b) A person may not restrict or deny an individual's access
13 to public accommodations based on the individual's exercise of the
14 right guaranteed under Subsection (a) of this section to refuse a
15 medical treatment.

16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment guaranteeing the right
20 of individuals to refuse medical treatments and to access public
21 accommodations."
