1	SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION
2	proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the creation of
3	the Texas power resiliency fund to finance backup power sources.
4	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
6	adding Section 49-q to read as follows:
7	Sec. 49-q. (a) The Texas power resiliency fund is created
8	as a special fund in the state treasury outside the general revenue
9	fund.
10	(b) As provided by general law, money in the Texas power
11	resiliency fund may be used without further appropriation and
12	administered only by the Texas Division of Emergency Management or
13	that division's successor in function to procure and deploy backup
14	power sources and to provide grants and loans to finance the
15	operation of backup power sources.
16	(c) The entity administering the Texas power resiliency
17	fund may establish separate accounts in the fund as necessary or
18	convenient for the fund's administration.
19	(d) The Texas power resiliency fund consists of:
20	(1) money credited, appropriated, or transferred to
21	the fund by the legislature;
22	(2) revenue that the legislature dedicates for deposit
23	to the credit of the fund;
24	(3) the returns received from the investment of the

- 1 money in the fund; and
- 2 (4) gifts, grants, and donations contributed to the
- 3 credit of the fund.
- 4 (e) The reasonable expenses of managing the fund's assets
- 5 shall be paid from the fund.
- 6 (f) For purposes of Section 22, Article VIII, of this
- 7 constitution:
- 8 <u>(1) money in the Texas power resiliency fund is</u>
- 9 dedicated by this constitution; and
- 10 (2) an appropriation of state tax revenues for the
- 11 purpose of depositing money to the credit of the Texas power
- 12 resiliency fund is treated as if it were an appropriation of
- 13 revenues dedicated by this constitution.
- 14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 15 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the
- 18 creation of the Texas power resiliency fund to finance backup power
- 19 sources."
