A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment recognizing the right of an
- 2 individual to refuse a vaccination.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 5 adding Section 36 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 36. An individual has the unalienable and natural
- 7 right to refuse a vaccination. The vaccination status of an
- 8 individual may not be made a condition of employment, travel,
- 9 school or other educational institution attendance, conducting
- 10 business, receiving medical treatment, receiving governmental
- 11 services, or any other action in this state.
- 12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 14 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment recognizing the right
- 16 of an individual to refuse a vaccination."
