S.J.R. No. 87

1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature
3 to exempt from ad valorem taxation equipment or inventory held by a
4 manufacturer of medical or biomedical products to protect the Texas
5 healthcare network and strengthen our medical supply chain.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
8 adding Section 1-x to read as follows:

9 Sec. 1-x. The legislature by general law may exempt from ad
10 valorem taxation the tangible personal property held by a
11 manufacturer of medical or biomedical products as a finished good
12 or used in the manufacturing or processing of medical or biomedical
13 products.

14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
15 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to authorize the
18 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation equipment or
19 inventory held by a manufacturer of medical or biomedical products
20 to protect the Texas healthcare network and strengthen our medical
21 supply chain."
