S.J.R. No. 87

A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature  
2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation certain tangible personal  
3 property held by a manufacturer of medical or biomedical products  
4 as a finished good or used in the manufacturing or processing of  
5 medical or biomedical products.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by  
8 adding Section 1-x to read as follows:

9 Sec. 1-x. The legislature by general law may exempt from ad  
10 valorem taxation the tangible personal property held by a  
11 manufacturer of medical or biomedical products as a finished good  
12 or used in the manufacturing or processing of medical or biomedical  
13 products.

14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be  
15 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.  
16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the  
17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to authorize the  
18 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation certain tangible  
19 personal property held by a manufacturer of medical or biomedical  
20 products as a finished good or used in the manufacturing or  
21 processing of medical or biomedical products."
