## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the creation of
- 2 the Texas energy fund and the authorization of other funding
- 3 mechanisms to support the construction, maintenance, and
- 4 modernization of electric generating facilities.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 49-q to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 49-q. (a) The Texas energy fund is created as a
- 9 special fund in the state treasury outside the general revenue
- 10 fund.
- 11 (b) As provided by general law, money in the Texas energy
- 12 fund may be administered and used, without further appropriation,
- only by the Public Utility Commission of Texas or that commission's
- 14 successor in function to provide loans to finance the construction,
- 15 maintenance, and modernization of electric generating facilities.
- 16 (c) The entity administering the Texas energy fund may
- 17 establish separate accounts in the fund as necessary or convenient
- 18 for the fund's administration.
- 19 <u>(d) The Texas energy fund consists of:</u>
- 20 (1) money transferred or deposited to the credit of
- 21 the fund by or as authorized by law, including money from any source
- 22 transferred or deposited to the credit of the fund at the discretion
- 23 of the entity administering the fund;
- 24 (2) revenue, including the proceeds of any fee,

- 1 assessment, or tax imposed by this state, that general law
- 2 dedicates for deposit to the credit of the fund; and
- 3 (3) investment earnings and interest earned on money
- 4 in the fund.
- 5 (e) The legislature may appropriate general revenue for the
- 6 purpose of depositing money to the credit of the Texas energy fund
- 7 to be used for the purposes of that fund.
- 8 (f) Regardless of whether the legislature directs that the
- 9 money be deposited to the credit of the Texas energy fund, the
- 10 legislature may appropriate general revenue to be expended for any
- 11 purpose related to construction, maintenance, or modernization of
- 12 electric generating facilities to ensure the reliability or
- 13 adequacy of an electric power grid in this state.
- 14 (g) For purposes of Section 22, Article VIII, of this
- 15 constitution:
- (1) money in the Texas energy fund is dedicated by this
- 17 constitution; and
- 18 (2) an appropriation of state tax revenues for the
- 19 purpose of depositing money to the credit of the Texas energy fund
- 20 is treated as if it were an appropriation of revenues dedicated by
- 21 this constitution.
- 22 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 23 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 24 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 25 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the
- 26 creation of the Texas energy fund and the authorization of other
- 27 funding mechanisms to support the construction, maintenance, and
