1 WHEREAS, Texas Tech University in Lubbock is celebrating the

2 100th anniversary of its founding in 2023; and

WHEREAS, Established as Texas Technological College in 1923,

4 the school opened two years later with an enrollment of 914

5 undergraduate students; in 1936, a division of graduate studies was

6 added, and in 1969 the college was renamed Texas Tech University;

7 the institution has distinguished itself by earning the Very High

8 Research Activity designation from the Carnegie Classification of

9 Institutions of Higher Education, as well as recognition as a

10 Veteran Friendly Institution and as an honoree on the "Best for

11 Vets: Employers" list by the Military Times; in the last three

12 years, its faculty members have received 23 Fulbright Scholar

13 Awards, 8 National Science Foundation Career Awards, and 7 National

14 Endowment for the Humanities grants; Texas Tech alumni include

15 governors from Texas and Colorado, multiple members of Congress and

16 state legislatures, stars of stage, screen, and music, and leaders

17 and captains of industry, science, engineering, agriculture, and

18 more; and

19 WHEREAS, Today, Texas Tech serves more than 40,000 students

20 and offers over 150 undergraduate, 100 graduate, and 50 doctoral

21 programs across its 13 colleges and schools; the university also

22 has international campuses and study abroad programs;

23 award-winning programs include the Davis College of Agricultural

24 Sciences and Natural Resources, the School of Medicine, the School

- 1 of Law, multiple colleges of engineering, and the Rawls College of
- 2 Business; in recent years, the university inaugurated the Texas
- 3 Tech School of Veterinary Medicine; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Texas Tech also takes great pride in its athletic
- 5 programs; the Red Raiders compete in 17 varsity sports, and 16 of
- 6 those teams have participated in the NCAA postseason or in a bowl
- 7 game; moreover, the university has won 27 Big 12 Conference titles,
- 8 including 11 in the past seven years, and its alumni include Olympic
- 9 athletes and Super Bowl champions; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Since its founding 100 years ago, Texas Tech has
- 11 provided generations of Texans with a strong foundation for
- 12 achievement, and in so doing, it has contributed significantly to
- 13 the prosperity and vitality of the Lone Star State; now, therefore,
