RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Citizens from Denton County are gathering in Austin 2 on March 22, 2023, to celebrate Denton County Day at the State 3 Capitol; and

WHEREAS, Located in North Texas and serving as the gateway to the Dallas-Fort Worth area, Denton County was created from the Peters colony grant by the Texas Legislature in 1846 and named for pioneer preacher, lawyer, and soldier John Bunyan Denton; the early years of the county saw its emergence as an agricultural center, and the arrival of the railroads in the 1880s ensured that the region's wheat and cotton would find distribution across the country; and

11 WHEREAS, The county has experienced remarkable growth in 12 recent years, and with a population of about 980,000, Denton is one 13 of the fastest growing counties in the nation; it has drawn a number 14 of corporate residents as well, including Federal Express, Sally 15 Beauty Holdings, Target, WinCo, Safran, and Peterbilt Motors; and

16 WHEREAS, The city of Denton, the county seat, is home to the University of North Texas and Texas Woman's University, which were 17 founded as Texas Normal College and Girls' Industrial College in 18 1890 and 1903, respectively; nearby Corinth hosts a campus of North 19 Central Texas College, which offers technical and occupational 20 21 classes to residents throughout the county and beyond, and the area is further served by 11 public school districts educating thousands 22 23 of young Texans at nearly 100 facilities; and

WHEREAS, Other attractions in the area include the wilderness

1 of the North Texas Greenbelt and the architecture of the Denton 2 County Courthouse-on-the-Square; moreover, the county is part of 3 the North Texas Horse Country, which is one of the largest regions 4 for horse breeding and training in the southwestern United States, 5 and the county also boasts the second-largest sports facility in 6 the nation, the Texas Motor Speedway, which draws hundreds of 7 thousands of race fans each year; and

8 WHEREAS, The citizens of this notable North Texas county are 9 working to preserve the best of their past even as they look forward 10 to a bright and promising future, and they are sure to figure 11 prominently in the story of the Lone Star State in the years ahead; 12 now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the 88th Texas Legislature hereby recognize March 22, 2023, as Denton County Day at the State Capitol and extend to the visiting delegation sincere best wishes for a meaningful and memorable stay in Austin.
