SJR 74 Parker/ et al. SP: Walle/ Holland

Proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the creation of the centennial parks conservation fund.

SB 14 Campbell/ Bettencourt/ Hall/ SP: Oliverson/ Klick/ et al. Hughes/ Kolkhorst/ et al.

Relating to prohibitions on the provision to certain children of procedures and treatments for gender transitioning, gender reassignment, or gender dysphoria and on the use of public money or public assistance to provide those procedures and treatments.

SB 22 Springer/ Blanco/ Creighton/ SP: Guillen/ Gerdes Eckhardt/ Hall/ et al.

Relating to the establishment of grant programs to provide financial assistance to qualified sheriff's offices, constable's offices, and prosecutor's offices in rural counties.

Relating to prohibiting the use of certain restraints, chemical irritants, or a Taser or similar device on certain public school students.
