IN RE: HB34 by Toth (Relating to a public school classroom safety review and referral program for students who engage in violent criminal conduct; creating a criminal offense.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that any impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources would not be significant.

Local Government Impact

This analysis assumes that districts would incur costs related to implementation of the bill, including establishing processes and procedures, designating a juvenile diversion administrator, and training staff. It is assumed that any fiscal impact to units of local government associated with enforcement, prosecution, supervision, or confinement would not be significant.
