**IN RE: HB34** by Toth (Relating to a public school classroom safety review and referral program for students who engage in violent criminal conduct; creating a criminal offense.), **As Introduced** 

#### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that any impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources would not be significant.

#### **Local Government Impact**
