**IN RE:** **HB357** by Bucy (relating to the requirements to access the online tracker of an application for a ballot to be voted by mail.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would modify certain authentication requirements used in the Ballot by Mail Tracker administered by the agency. It is assumed any required modifications to this system could be completed with existing resources.
