IN RE: HB476 by Jones, Jolanda (Relating to the release of certain defendants detained in jail pending trial.),
Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

Local Government Impact

Counties could experience a cost savings if there is a limit on the length of time a defendant may be detained.
