IN RE: HB669 by Thierry (Relating to school districts and open-enrollment charter schools providing panic alert devices in classrooms.), **As Introduced**

Local education agencies (districts and charter schools) would need to purchase and install panic alert devices in all classrooms in the districts. The costs associated with this requirement would vary based on size and existing infrastructure.
