IN RE: HB1149 by Swanson (Relating to requiring parental consent for psychological or psychiatric examination, testing, or treatment conducted by a school district employee.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

Local Government Impact

This bill would require school districts and open-enrollment charter schools to adopt processes and procedures of when and how to obtain consent and training to staff. However, no significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
