IN RE: HB1455 by Anchía (relating to health care benefits of persons wrongfully imprisoned.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would extend participation in the Texas Employees Group Benefits Program (GBP) health coverage to spouses and dependents of individuals determined to have been wrongfully imprisoned. It is assumed that any related costs would be insignificant.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
